ESTATE

The Château de la Terrière has stood in Cercié since the 16th century, in the heart of the Beaujolais region. It is one of the oldest estates in the region. The vines cover a total of 28 hectares and are 50 years old on average. They extend due south, to the mid-slope of a granite hill. The aim of Yoan Pitoiset, who is in charge of the château, is to give the wine enough time to fully develop its expression and reflect the complexity of the terroir.

SOIL

The vines form part of the Régnié Cru in lieu-dit of "La Tour Bourdon". Stony, white granite soil with old alluvial deposits.

VINIFICATION & AGEING

Traditional whole-bunch vinification. Approx. 15-day maceration. Aged in stainless steel vats.

TASTING NOTES

The nose is very aromatic, with strawberry and cherry notes. Rich in the mouth, this is a premium Beaujolais-Villages.

FOOD & WINE PAIRINGS

The perfect partner for mixed salads, terrines and grilled fish. VEGGIE: Vegetable terrine.
